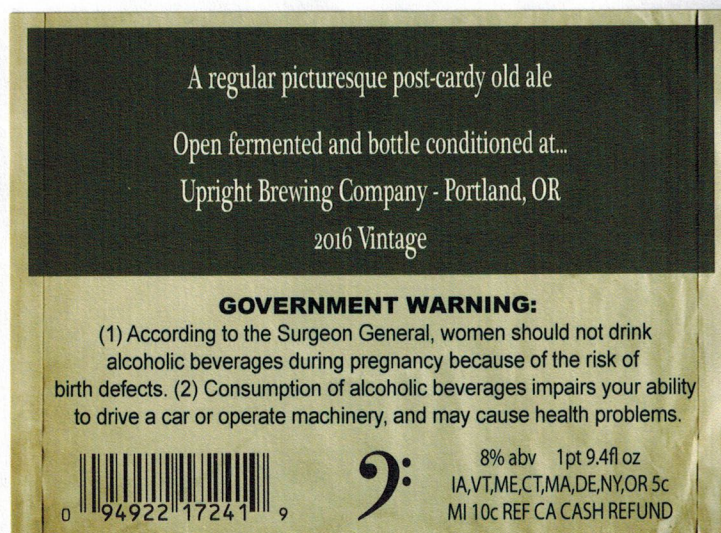
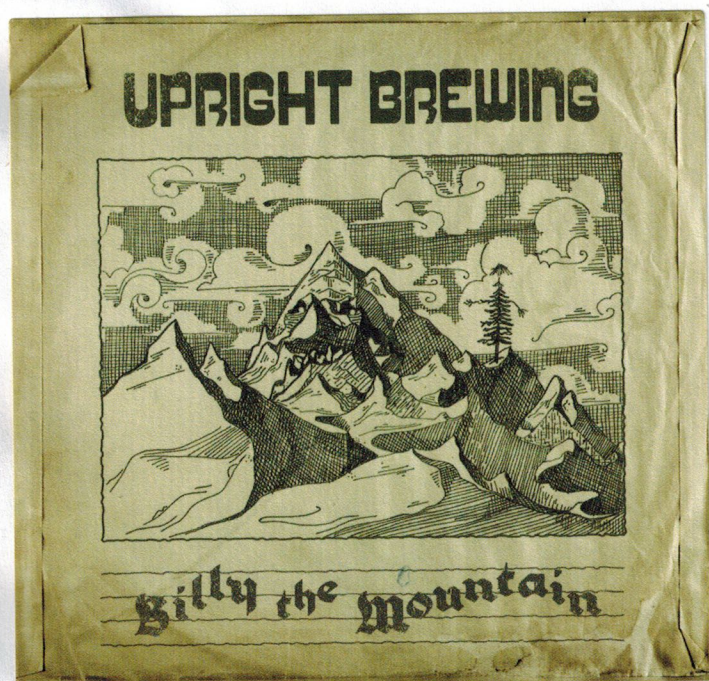


This 2016 vintage of Billy the Mountain marks the final release of our 19<sup>th</sup> century style Old Ale. This batch blends casks from 2013, 2014, and 2015, with a freshly brewed Scottish ale, combining the sherry-like character and acidity of the aged beer with smooth toffee flavors and residual sugars from the young beer. A thread through all the years has been an overripe tropical note rooted in *brettanomyces*, present here along with a slight ash note and plenty of leather and oak. The beer is bottled still which allows for the components to interact and slowly develop light carbonation. Billy is best kept at cellar temperature and served the same, in a snifter or wine glass.



Grains: pale, ashburne mild, caramel, roast barley  
Hops: magnum, goldings, willamette  
Also: molasses  
Bottled October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016  
Yield: 91 cases, 8% abv
