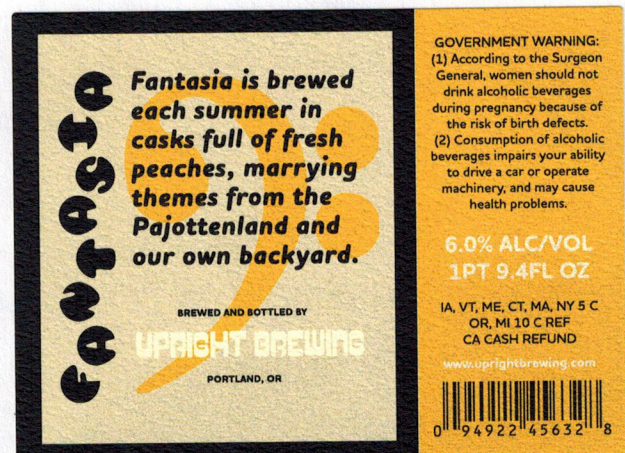
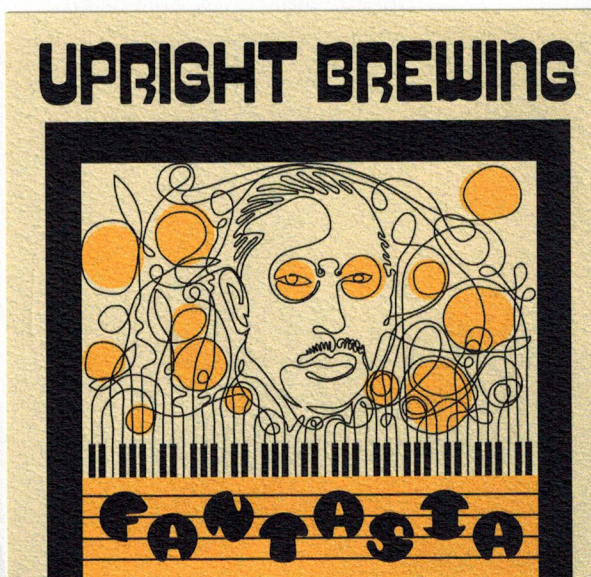


2018 is the eighth vintage for Fantasia, our first barrel fermented fruit beer. We opted for two different peach varieties harvested late into summer and full of flavor. Perhaps the most well structured and balanced batch to date, this vintage is subtly complex with a restrained fermentation profile that allows the fruit, oak, and malt nuances to show clearly within a mineral rich body akin to expressive riesling wines. Bright acidity up front softens quickly on the palate, leaving an easy and enjoyable finish that lingers just enough to invite another sip. As always the beer is conditioned properly in house and best within a year before the 2019 is ready.



Grains: two-row & caramel

Hops: 2015 harvest glacier, aged at room temp

Peaches: Baird Family Orchards

Brewed: August 17<sup>th</sup> 2017

Bottled September 5<sup>t</sup> 2018

Yield: 155 cases and 8 kegs, 6% abv
