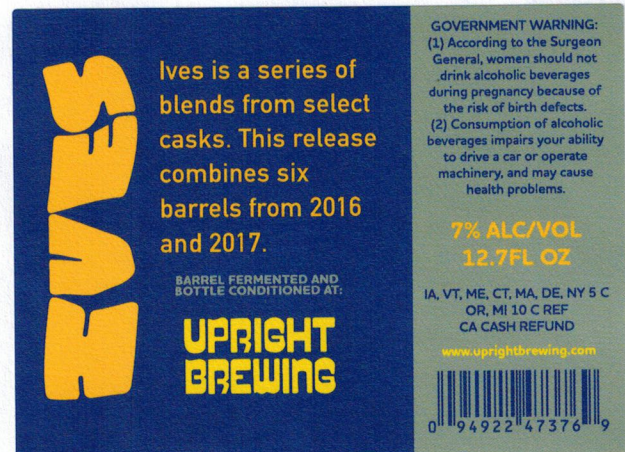
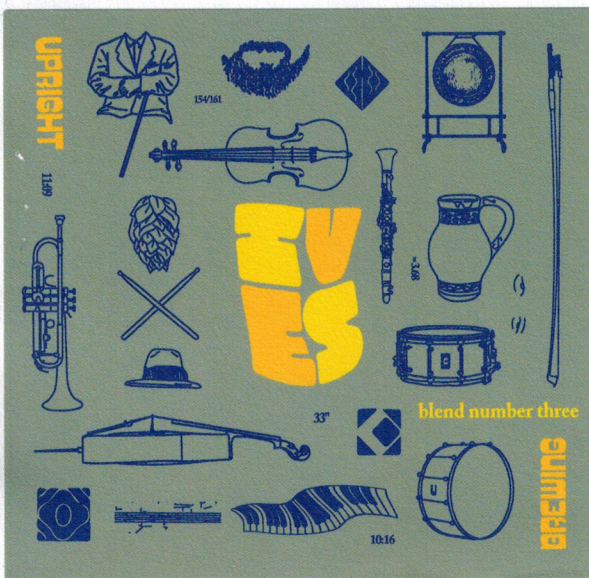


Ives is a label we created for a series of “wild” wheat based beers rooted in the classics from Brussels. In typical Upright fashion, our take is not meant to copy an existing style or specific beer, but to use other examples as a starting point and inspiration. All of the beers under this label use raw wheat and an unusual mash process with the intention of slowly drawing out the barrel fermentation and aging process. This release blended six casks that showed aromatic balance and moderate acidity in barrel before bottle conditioning. The finished beer opens forward in the nose but softens as it warms, yielding a profile both simple and complex, capped by a notably dry finish.



Grist: pils, raw wheat, flaked wheat
Hops: columbia, warm aged 2013 hallertauer
Brewed: December 30th 2016 & January 9th 2017
Bottled May 23rd 2018
Total yield: 158 cases and 8 kegs, 7% abv
