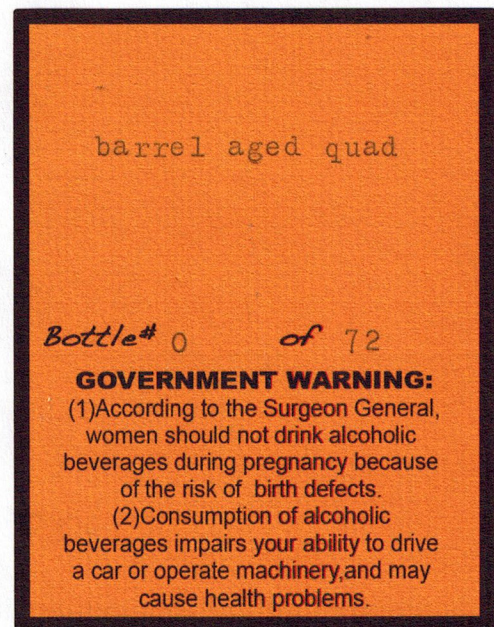
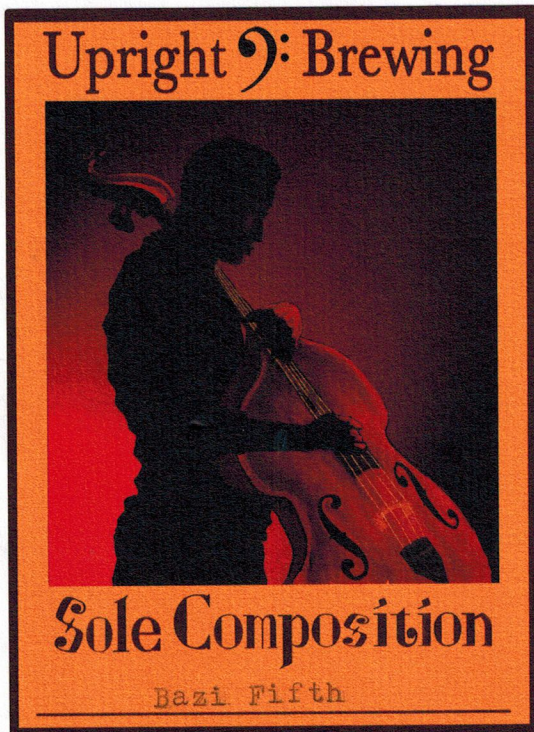


The Bazi Fifth Anniversary Quad is one of the brewery's few forays into abbey styles. While mostly traditional in formulation, there are some notable difference between our take and the famous beers of Belgium. The grist is exactly as one would expect in a Quad, with dark candy syrup adding to the fermentables and flavor profile. The twists begin with the yeast strain selection, where we employed our house blend of saison yeasts. That distinction is significant as the beer shows more acidity, brighter fruitiness, and more complex spice notes than typical abbey strains. After primary fermentation, the beer spent several weeks rounding out in port-finish whiskey casks where character from both beverages lends nuance to the Quad, along with an oak derived tannic edge that rides along the slightly tart flavor.
